Yeoman being Sick and Weak in Body but of Sound Mind Memory and Understanding do make and publish
this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (to wit) WHEREAS I am seized and Possessed
of the Tythes of Little Mayne Farm in the said County of Dorset I give and Devise the same together with
all other my Lands Tenements and Hereditaments in Broad Mayne aforesaid or elsewhere in the said County of
Dorset with the Rents Issues and Profits of all and singular the said Premises unto James Sherron and William
Thresher of Broad Mayne aforesaid Yeomen To have and to hold the said Tythes Lands Tenements
Hereditaments and Premises to them the said James Sherron and William Thresher their Executors Administrators
and Assignes from and immediately after my Decease for and during and unto the full End and Term of Ninety
Nine Years from thence next ensuing and fully to be complete and ended without Impediment of Waste IN
WITNESSE whereof and to the intent and purpose that they the said James Sherron and William Thresher their
Executors Administrators and Assignes do and shall out of the Rents Issues and Profits thereof or thereby arising
or by an Assignment of the said Term or by Grant Mortgage or Sale of the said Premises or any part thereof
raise and Levy such a Sum of Money as will be sufficient to enable my said Trustees to pay off and discharge
the following Legacies as they shall respectively become payable (Viz) To my Daughter Elizabeth One hundred
Pounds to be paid her at her Age of One and Twenty Years or Day of Marriage which shall first happen with
Interest for the same in the mean time at Four Pounds per Cent To my Daughter Mary the Wife of Walter
Spicer One hundred Pounds which said One hundred Pounds my Will and meaning is shall go in Payment
and Discharge of one Bond or Obligation wherein I now stand bound to the said Walter Spicer for that Sum
ALSO I give to my said Daughter Mary Spicer one Shilling To my Daughter Jane Talbot I give One hundred
Pounds to be paid her by my said Trustees at her attaining the Age of one and Twenty Years or Day of
Marriage which shall first happen with Interest for the same in the mean time at four Pounds per Cent
To my Son George I give Three hundred Pounds to be paid him by my said Trustees at his attaining his full
age of one and Twenty Years To my Daughter Susanna I give and bequeath to her the Sum of One Hundred
Pounds to be paid her at her age of One and Twenty Years or Day of Marriage which shall first happen
And my Will is and I do desire that my said Trustees do out of the Rents Issues and Profits of the Premises
herein before Deviced to them, Maintain Educate and breed up my said Children George and Susanna until
they respectively become intitled to their respective Legacies by virtue of this my Will ALSO I give to Robert
Talbot Son of my Daughter Mary Spicer the Sum of fifty Pounds to be paid him at his age of one and Twenty
Years and in the mean time to be Educated and Maintained by my said Trustees out of the Rents and Profits
of the said Premises the same as my said Children George and Susanna are ALSO I give to my Servant
Sarah Aysh the Sum of Two Shillings a week to be paid her Weekly and every Week by my said Trustees
their Executors Administrators or Assignes out of the Issues and Profits of the Tythes of Little Mayne farm
for and during the Term of her Life To Commence immediately upon my Decease ALSO I give to James
Aysh Son of the said Sarah Aysh Ten Pounds to bind him out an Apprentice to some Trade as my said Trustees
shall think proper ALSO I give him the further Sum of fifty Pounds to be paid him by my said Trustees when
out of his Apprenticeship to set him up in Trade And in the mean time before he is put out an Apprentice
to be bred up and Maintained by my said Trustees out of the Rents and Profits of my said Estates the same
as my said Children are - And from and immediately after my said Trustees have raised Moneys sufficient
and have paid off all the Legacies their respective Legacies at the times and in manner as herein is before

appointed Then my Will is And I do hereby give and Devise all and singular the Premises aforesaid and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders of all and singular those my freehold Lands Tenements and Hereditaments aforesaid with the Rents Issues and Profits thereof and of every part thereof (Subject only to the Payment of Two Shillings a Week to the said Sarah Aysh for her Life as aforesaid) unto my Son William Talbot and his Issue And in Default of his Issue To my Son George and his Issue And in Default of his Issue Then to such of my Daughters as shall be then living and to each of their Heirs and Assignes as Tenants in Common and not as joint Tenants. And my Will is that my said Trustees do then Assign over the Remainder of the said Term unto such Person or Persons as shall be then intitled to the Premises abovementioned by virtue of this my will And pay him her or them the Surplus of the Rents and Profits of my said Estates then in their hands Share and Share alike And that my said Trustees do in the mean time take Care of and Educate and Maintain my said Son William out of the Rents and Profits of my said Estates as the others of my said Children are herein before directed to be And further I do hereby empower my said Trustees and the Survivor of them his and their Executors Administrators and Assignes to reimburse themselves all such Costs Charges and Expenses they any or either of them shall at any time be put unto on Account of the Execution of the Trust hereby in them rejoiced And Lastly all the rest residue and remainder of my Goods Chattels and personal Estate of what nature or kind soever (after all my just Debts and funeral Expenses are fully satisfied and paid) I give and bequeath to the said James Sherrin and William Sherrin and the Survivor of them his Executors Administrators or Assignes In Trust by and for my said Son William Talbot And I do hereby constitute and appoint these the said James Sherrin and William Sherrin joint Executors of the my last Will and Testament In Trust for my said Son William Talbot as aforesaid hereby revoking and making void all other Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament contained in these two Sheets of Paper Set my Hand and Seal the Twenty Second Day of March in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Seven

A Codicil to be added to and be part of the last Will and Testament of and the above named William Talbot Esq. That in case my said Son William shall happen to die without Issue before he attain the age of Twenty one Years and my Son George shall become Possessed and Intitled to my Real Estates Then I will that the Legacy of Three Hundred Pounds given in and by my last Will to my said Son George shall go to and be equally divided between my said Daughters Mary Spier and Jane and Susanna Talbot Share and Share alike Also I give my Watch to my Son George And whereas my said Daughter Elizabeth is already of full Age I will that the Legacy given her in and by my said Will be paid to her in Twelve Months next after my Death In Witness whereof I have to this Codicil set my Hand and Seal the said Twenty Second Day of March in the Year aforesaid Signed Sealed and published by the said Testator as and for Codicil to be added to and be part of his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who Subscribed our Names in his presence
